








Treatment Pathway



ToP consultation and start of treatment at RHH, Ward G1

- Ultrasound scan to confirm gestation and appropriate abortion treatment
- Vaginal swabs to check for infection
- Blood taken if required
- Documentation

Abortion Treatment

- Early Medical Abortion
 Home Administration
 1st tablet provided and medication to take at home 2 days later.
- Early Medical Abortion Hospital Administration 1st tablet provided then return to the hospital 48 hours later for the second stage of medication, then home to complete treatment.
- Medical Abortion:
 1st tablet provided, then
 return to the hospital 48
 hours later for treatment.
 The length of this stay will
 vary from 4 10 hours
 depending on gestation
 (more than 12 weeks may
 need to stay overnight)

Post ToP counselling

Available if required, up to 4 sessions can be offered.
